2018-2019 CCPOR AWARDS

ULTIMATE HORSE ALL-AROUND AWARD QUALIFICATION - Dec/Jan Combined

(Must show to all eight (8) judges in each division)

YOUTH WALK/TROT (5-10)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Youth Walk/Trot classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

(Classes eligible are Youth Walk/Trot 5-10 Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

NOVICE YOUTH

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Youth classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

(Classes eligible are Novice Youth Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

YOUTH (13 & Under)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Youth Performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

(Classes eligible are Youth 13 & Under Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

YOUTH (14-18)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Youth Performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

(Classes eligible are Youth 14-18 Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

Overall high point of each Youth division (4 total) gets their name in a drawing for a High Point Saddle

NOVICE AMATEUR

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Amateur Performance Classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR. (Classes eligible are Novice Amateur Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

AMATEUR WALK/TROT

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Walk/Trot Performance Classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR. (Classes eligible are Amateur Walk/Trot Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)
AMATEUR CLASSIC (19-44)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Classic Performance Classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR. (Classes eligible are Amateur Classic 19-44 Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

AMATEUR MASTERS (45 & over)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Masters Performance Classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR. (Classes eligible - Amateur Masters 45 & Over Trail, WP, Horsemanship, Showmanship, HUS, HSE, Halter)

Overall high point of each Amateur division (4 total) gets their name in a drawing for a High Point Saddle

OPEN HORSE (all ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) Open performance classes (2 yo, 3 yo, Junior, Senior, or All Age) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

(Classes eligible are Junior WP, Senior WP, 2yo WP, 3 yo WP, Junior Trail, Senior Trail, Western Riding, Reining, HUS 2yo, HUS 3yo, HUS Open, Ranch Pleasure, Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding, Halter)

Saddle awarded to overall high point Open Horse from above classes - Reserve award also given





HIGH POINT AWARD QUALIFICATION - Dec/Jan Combined

(Must show to all eight (8) judges in each division)

OPEN HALTER

Overall high point Open Mare, Gelding & Stallion

AMATEUR HALTER

Overall high point Amateur Mare, Gelding & Stallion

GREEN HORSE

All Ages – Must compete in at least three (3) Green Horse performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

JUNIOR HORSE

Must compete in at least three (3) Open (2yo, 3yo, Junior or All Age) performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

SENIOR HORSE

Must compete in at least three (3) Open (Senior or All Age) performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

AMATEUR SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Solid Paint Bred performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan) and Amateur Solid Paint Bred Halter in each POR.

YOUTH SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Youth Solid Paint Bred performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan) and Youth Solid Paint Bred Halter in each POR.

OPEN SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Open Solid Paint Bred performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan) and Open Solid Paint Bred Halter in each POR.

ALL BREED (All Ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) All Breed performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Halter class will not count.





HIGH POINT WESTERN AWARD QUALIFICATION - Dec/Jan Combined

(Must show to all eight (8) judges in each division)

NOVICE YOUTH

Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Youth classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Classes that count are Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, & Showmanship. Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (13 & Under)

Must compete in at least three (3) Youth 13 & Under performance classes (Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Western Riding, Showmanship). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (14 -18)

Must compete in at least three (3) Youth 14-18 performance classes (Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship, Trail Ranch Horse, Western Riding, Ranch Pleasure, Reining, Ranch Riding). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

NOVICE AMATEUR (All Ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Amateur performance classes (Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Western Riding, Showmanship, Ranch Riding, Trail Ranch Horse) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

AMATEUR CLASSIC (19-44)

Must compete in at least three (3) Classic Amateur performance classes (Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

AMATEUR MASTERS (45 & Over)

Must compete in at least three (3) Masters Amateur performance classes (Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Showmanship) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

OPEN (All Ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) Open performance classes (2 yo, 3 yo, Junior, Senior, or All Age) in each POR (Dec & Jan). Classes that count are Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Western Riding, Showmanship, Ranch Pleasure, Reining, Ranch Riding, & Trail Ranch Horse. Must also compete in Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

ALL BREED (All Ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) All Breed performance classes in each POR (Dec & Jan). Halter class will not count.





HIGH POINT ENGLISH AWARD QUALIFICATION - Dec/Jan Combined

(Must show to all eight (8) judges in each division)

NOVICE YOUTH

Must compete in at least two (2) Novice Youth performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation) in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (13 & Under)

Must compete in at least two (2) Youth 13 & Under performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation, Equitation over fences, Working Hunter, Jumping, Hunter Hack) in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (14 -18)

Must compete in at least three (3) Youth 14-18 performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation, Equitation over fences, Working Hunter, Jumping, Hunter Hack) in each POR (Dec & Jan). Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

NOVICE AMATEUR (All Ages)

Must compete in at least two (2) Novice Amateur performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

AMATEUR CLASSIC (19-44)

Must compete in at least two (2) Classic Amateur performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

AMATEUR MASTERS (45 & Over)

Must compete in at least two (2) Masters Amateur performance classes (HUS, Hunt Seat Equitation) in each POR (Dec & Jan), and either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter in each POR.

OPEN (All Ages)

Must compete in at least three (3) Open performance classes (2 yo, 3 yo, Junior, Senior, or All Age) in each POR (Dec & Jan). Classes that count are Working Hunter, Jumping, Hunter Hack, HUS. Must also compete in Open Halter or Open Performance Halter in each POR.

ALL BREED (All Ages)

Must compete in at least One (1) All Breed performance class in each POR (Dec & Jan). Halter class will not count.





HIGH POINT QUALIFICATION FOR EACH 4-JUDGE POR

(Must show to four (4) judges in each division)

APHA YOUTH WALK/TROT (5-10)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Walk/Trot performance classes. Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

NOVICE YOUTH

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Youth performance classes. Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (13 & Under)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Youth 13 & Under performance classes. Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

YOUTH (14-18)

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Youth 14-18 performance classes. Youth Halter not required but will count (Class 247 or 264 in both POR's).

AMATEUR WALK/TROT

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Walk/Trot performance classes. Must show in either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter.

NOVICE AMATEUR

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Novice Amateur performance classes. Must show in either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter.

CLASSIC AMATEUR 19-44

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Classic Amateur performance classes. Must show in either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter.

MASTERS AMATEUR 45 & Over

One horse/one rider basis. Must compete in at least three (3) Masters Amateur performance classes. Must show in either Amateur Halter or Amateur Performance Halter.

APHA GREEN HORSE

Must compete in at least three (3) Green Horse performance classes. Must show in either Open Halter or Open Performance Halter.

JUNIOR HORSE

Must compete in at least three (3) Open (2yo, 3yo, Junior or All Age) performance classes. Must show in either Open Halter or Open Performance Halter.





SENIOR HORSE

Must compete in at least three (3) Open (Senior or All Age) performance classes. Must show in Open Halter or Open Performance Halter.

ALL BREED

Must compete in at least three (3) All Breed performance classes. Halter class will not count.

AMATEUR SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Amateur Solid Paint Bred performances classes. Must also show in Amateur Solid Paint Bred Halter.

YOUTH SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Youth Solid Paint Bred performance classes. Must also show in Youth Solid Paint Bred Halter.

SOLID PAINT BRED

Must compete in at least three (3) Open Solid Paint Bred performance classes. Must also show in Open Solid Paint Bred Halter.

AMATEUR SOLID PAINT BRED ULTIMATE YEARLING

Must compete in the SPB Amateur Yearling Longe Line, SPB Amateur Yearling In Hand Trail, and SPB Amateur All Ages Halter. December POR only.

SOLID PAINT BRED ULTIMATE YEARLING

Must compete in the SPB Open Yearling Longe Line, SPB Open Yearling In Hand Trail, and SPB Open Junior 2 & Under Halter. December POR only.

AMATEUR ULTIMATE YEARLING

Must compete in the Amateur Yearling Longe Line, Amateur Yearling In Hand Trail, and Amateur Junior 2 & Under Halter. December POR only.

ULTIMATE YEARLING

Must compete in the Open Yearling Longe Line, Open Yearling In Hand Trail, and Open Yearling Halter. December POR only.

AWARD TIE BREAKER SYSTEM

In the event of ties, the placings of exhibitors involved in the tie will be used to determine the winner. If necessary due to a tie of placings, Judge A as listed in the premium will be the tie-breaker judge.
